Dear Parents,

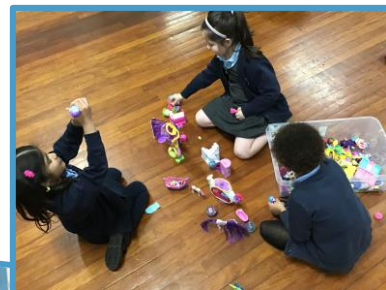
Breakfast Club and After School Club continue to expand the school day, which gives the children more time with their friends to socialise, discover, create, be active and have fun, here's our news:

Booking

All children attending wraparound care sessions need to be pre-booked in writing (email or paper)

Bookings or cancellations need to be received by the school office at least one school day in advance of the session. (This means bookings or cancellations for a Monday need to be received by the school office on a Friday morning.) Booking and cancellation forms can be found on the website or sent home on request. Sessions booked but not attended by your child (except because of absence to school) will be charged at the full amount of the session.

Payment

Payment can be made online at Parent Pay - you will receive a password to access your account. Sessions your child has attended will be added by the office staff regularly. Payment can also be made by cash, cheque (Cheques made payable to Stoneraise School), childcare vouchers, or through the Government's Tax-free Childcare system.
